Job Description: Keeps working areas in production departments of industrial establishment in clean and orderly condition, performing any combination of duties required to maintain clean and safe work environment. Duties involve use of a variety of labor intensive procedures. Physical Demands - Active w/medium lifting, carrying, and moving (up to 50 lbs); General Educational Development R2 M1 L2; Aptitudes - Average General Learning Ability, Numerical, Spatial, Motor Coordination, and Manual Dexterity.

1. Can demonstrate ability to perform routine maintenance activities, such as sweeping, mopping, scrubbing, vacuuming, polishing, and waxing, to keep industrial working areas in clean and orderly condition. (R, S, T)
2. Can demonstrate ability to transport raw materials and semifinished products or supplies between departments or buildings to supply machine tenders or operators with material for processing, using handtruck or other industrial moving equipment. (R, S, T)
3. Can demonstrate ability to arrange boxes, material, and other industrial equipment in neat and orderly manner. (R, S, T)
4. Can demonstrate ability to clean lint, dust, oil, and grease from machines, overhead pipes, and conveyors, using brushes, air hoses, or steam cleaner. (R, S, T)

6. Can demonstrate proper technique used to scrub processing tanks and vats. (R, S, T)
7. Can demonstrate ability to clean floors, using water hose and floor drier. (R, S, T)
8. Can demonstrate proper technique used to force cleaning solution through production machinery, piping, or vats. (R, S, T)
9. Can demonstrate proper technique used to lubricate machinery. (R, S, T)
10. Can demonstrate ability to collect reusable scrap for salvage and place in proper containers or areas. (R, S, T)
11. Can demonstrate proper technique used to burn waste and clean incinerator. (R, S, T)
12. Can demonstrate ability to pick up refuse from plant grounds and maintain area by cutting grass or shoveling snow. (R, S, T)
13. Can demonstrate ability to appropriately service, repair, and/or replace cleaning and maintenance equipment and machinery. (R, S, T)
