Job Description: Lubricates moving parts of automotive vehicles, such as automobiles, buses, and trucks.

CORE SKILL COMPETENCIES/INDICATORS:

1. Can demonstrate familiarity with basic hand tools and their use, such as screwdrivers, pliers, wrenches, micrometers, calipers, gauges, etc. (R, T)
2. Can demonstrate ability to safely and appropriately raise vehicles in preparation of service, using hydraulic jacks, floor jacks, jack stands, lifts or similar equipment. (R, T)
3. Can demonstrate proper technique used to check fluid levels, such as gas, water, oil, brake fluid, antifreeze, power steering fluid, etc. (T, S)
4. Can demonstrate ability to fill/refill fluids to the appropriate levels utilizing the appropriate product. (R, T)

9. Can demonstrate proper technique used to check air pressure of tires and refill to appropriate levels. (T, S)
10. Can demonstrate ability to accurately inspect parts for wear/damage to determine the need for replacement. (R, T, S)
11. Can demonstrate ability to replace windshield wipers, etc. (R, T)
12. Can demonstrate ability to utilize a check list to assure all important parts have been examined. (R, IN, T)
13. Can demonstrate ability to accurately inventory and record supplies/materials on hand. (R, IN, S)
14. Can demonstrate ability to safely and appropriately move supplies and materials using hand or power operated equipment. (T, S)
15. Can demonstrate ability to receive and sort materials/supplies and store in appropriate area. (R, IN, S)
